Similarly, Certify Impact automatically identifies proposed changes to the SAP application, either directly from the transport or through the business process change analyzer in the [SAP Solution Manager](#) application management solution, and recommends and executes business process tests based upon them. The combined Worksoft and RQM solution helps IBM customers manage the end-to-end tests of their business processes, lowering the costs and risks associated with deploying new SAP functionality or application updates.

Today’s announcement extends the relationship between Worksoft and IBM.
